Beanstack Reading Challenge

Our libraries offer an online tool called Beanstack that children and teens can use to track their reading for our 2022 Summer Reading Program. Teens have the ability to register themselves.

- 1. To create your Beanstack account, go to <http://moglibraries.beanstack.org> to create an account.**
- 2. Choose the Register an Individual or Family option.**
- 3. Choose the "I am registering myself" option.**
- 4. Enter the required information - first name, last name, username, password, age, grade level, and school name are required.**
- 5. Click the Next button below the form.**

Starting May 30, you can track your reading and log the amount of books or minutes you have read.

- 1. To record your reading, click the Log Reading button.**
- 2. Choose the Log Type - Activity, Minutes, or Books.**
- 3. If you choose Activity, type the name of the activity, type a description into the dialog box, and click the Log button.**
- 4. If you choose Minutes, enter the number of minutes, the title and author of the book (optional), and click the Log button. (Smartphones cameras can scan the ISBN of the book to automatically enter the title.)**
- 5. If you chose Books, select the date that you read, enter the title and author (optional), chose if you would like to leave a review (optional), and click the Log button.**
